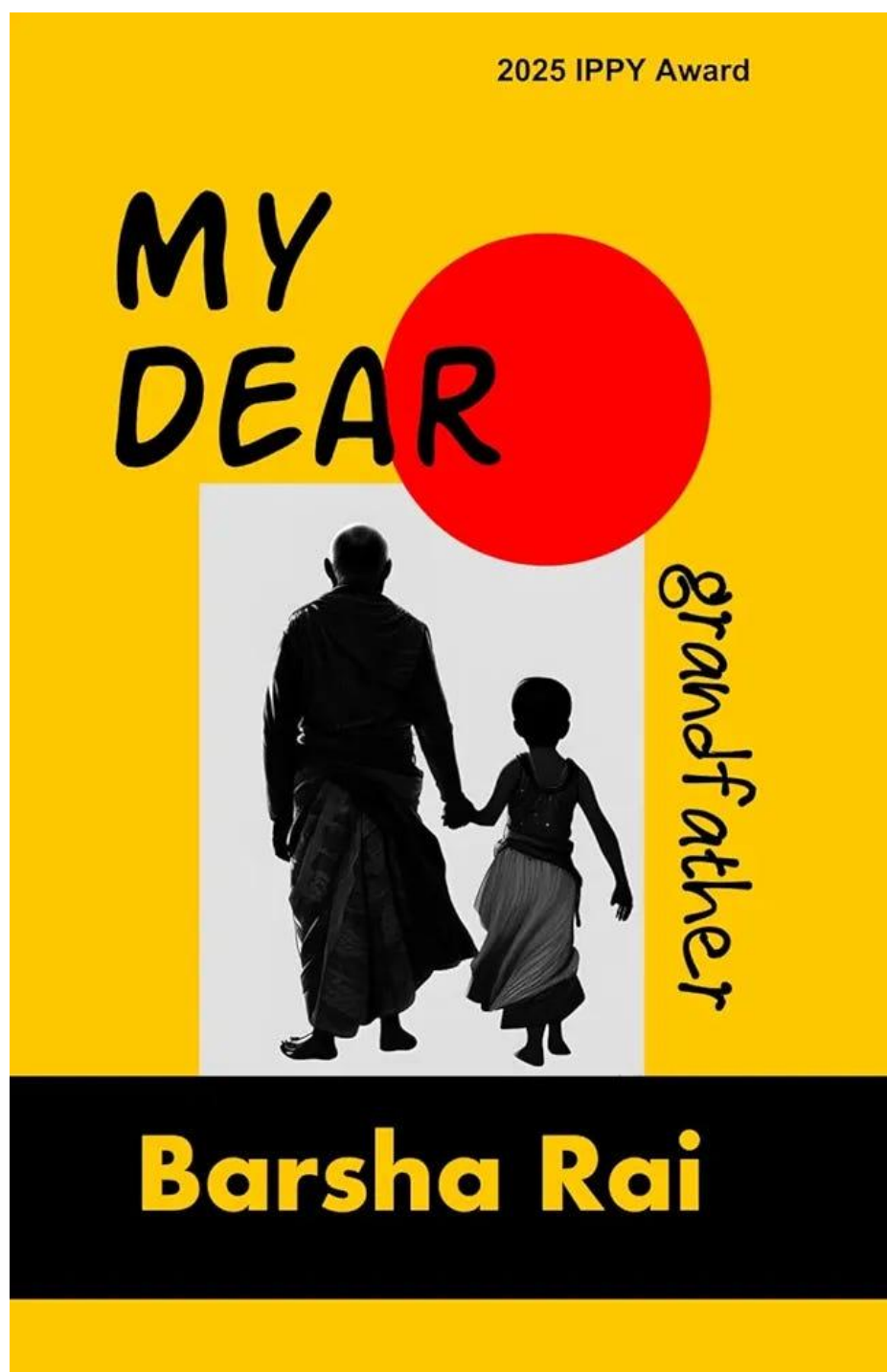


My Dear Grandfather: A Mystery Steeped in Culture and Family Secrets
